WINEMAKING

Winemaking note

Fruit for the Rose was harvested from our vineyards during March 2019. The juice was run off the skins early, in order to extract only the perfect amount of colour and then inoculated and fermented cool. Post fermentation the wine was fined, cold stabilised and filtered, ready for bottling. The entire process from vineyard to bottle was less than 6 weeks, keeping the wine fresh and vivacious.
