Colour

Golden straw.

Nose

Aromas of tropical fruits and peaches with just a hint of lightly toasted oak.

Palate

The palate exhibits fresh, ripe Chardonnay flavours of melon and fig with a delicate, creamy texture and a crisp, clean finish.

Food Recommendations

Strange Birds Chardonnay is a lovely, fresh and clean wine that is great on its own and perfect with seafood, light pasta and pizza or char cooked chicken roast.

WINEMAKING

Winemaking note

This wine was crafted from 100 percent Chardonnay grapes, sourced from our vineyards in South Eastern Australia. Grapes were picked and crushed during the cool of night so as to retain their fresh, varietal flavours. The juice was then divided into various parcels. Each parcel of juice underwent a different treatment, such as malolactic fermentation; fermentation and aging with French oak; or spending an extended period on yeast lees. These treatments resulted in an individually flavoured parcel of wine with the unique character and personality of the final blend a result of the special handling of various winemaking techniques.
